## **Building LINKs & Arches** with the Bathgate Community

In 2019 the Procession Committee took the very difficult decision not to erect the three span arch in George Street. This was mainly down to the lack of volunteers to take over from those who had selflessly given their time in years past. It also became apparent that we needed skilled people using the correct health and safety equipment (gone are the days that you could just climb up a few ladders tied together by rope). The "Save the Arches 2020" campaign was in full swing when the global pandemic hit and the cancellation of the 2020 and 2021 Processions meant this long standing tradition never managed to happen.

Since returning last year, the new Procession Committee faced the same issue. however, we are pleased to announce that the George Street arches will return in 2024!

The wonderful team at C-urb, a LINK Contractor, have agreed to undertake and deliver this project. One of LINK's core values is "to strive to ensure there is a positive social impact from our activities and work with others who share our aims", and what better way to make a positive impact within the local community than to bring back the arches. A sight that many in Bathgate have missed!

C-urb and LINK will use their dedicated team of skilled workers and are looking for members of the community to help where they can. 

## A ROYAL WELCOME TO OUR 2023 ORATOR

Although I have not attended a Procession Day for some years, they were always a central highlight of my childhood and youth – let's not say how many years ago that was!

Life has taken me away from Bathgate, first to St Andrews and Aberdeen for degree and PhD respectively, and, for the past twenty years, to the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst, where I have had the privilege of teaching a consistently fine cohort of UK and International Officer Cadets (including some roval representatives of both this and other states - Princess Marjorie is not my first brush with monarchy), as part of a career that has seen me deliver across the world, from conferences alongside aged Russian diplomats in Moscow to conflict analysis courses as far afield as Oman and Chile.

I never walked in the procession although I am looking forward to being driven along the route this year, and I never played a part as an archer, a clansman or as any of the Royal party. My memories are all from the sidelines, outside Avon Road, where my grandparents lived, opposite the Green Tree pub, a fortuitous spot for refreshments that I hear is still as busy on Procession Day.

Like all good academics, as I sit in my office, surrounded by books (some written by me, most not) and lots of paperwork - as well as memories and mementos from foreign trips and of family occasions - I am racking my brains for recollections of Procession Days past. Bunting and arches, decorated streets, seeing the 'shows' being set up across from St Mary's on the red ash park. Boxes for the children at the Creamery Park. Watching the procession, the pipe bands (scared of them as a child - not now), the occasionally mistimed majorettes. suffering float envy as Balbardie's latest extravagant effort drove past.

However, it was my granny who best summed up the Procession Day experience. She loved it, loved being once again the central hub of family life, both for the procession and for the pies and sausage rolls afterwards, where space was at a premium and you had to move quickly to even grab a spot on the stairs, let alone in the living room. She would, with her sisters, act as a cheerleading squad, dancing on the side-lines – occasionally in front of the oncoming procession – waving her flag and exhorting those walking to enjoy themselves a little more. She was even pictured in full flow in the Courier one year, named as 'Local Bathgate woman

enjoying herself', which she clearly was. Anonymous then, but let me name her now – my much missed granny was Agnes Slater, a Bathgate worthy, who I like to think will get as much of a kick out of me naming her in the official Procession programme as I am getting from being the 2023 Orator.

Here's to a sunny and successful Procession Day this year.

# History with Harry

## An introduction to Bathgate's royal history

Our annual and treasured Procession allows all Bathgate bairns (native and adopted) an opportunity to celebrate our Royal History and the unique part Bathgate played in the formation of the Royal House of Stuart whose Kings and Queens ruled Scotland from 1371, before the whole of Great Britain in 1603 until 1714.

The honour of a young person being chosen to play Walter or Princess Marjorie in our Procession is the ultimate accolade for any Bathgate family. So let's explore the fascinating history behind Bathgate's often forgotten and little told Royal Heritage.

Our town name derives from the ancient Cumbrian language once spoken locally, with the rough translation of the original name Bathgate as Batket, meaning "wood of the boar ". Bathgate is first mentioned in print in 1160, after King Malcolm instructs "Uchtred Sheriff of Linlithgow" to grant lands in Bathgate to the Monks of Holyrood Abbey for agricultural use and the building of a Church.

By the late 13th century, Bathgate boasted a Royal Residence with an impressive castle situated on what are now the 9th and 10th holes of Bathgate Golf club. Such was the prestige of our castle and lands, King Robert the Bruce, fresh from his triumph on the field of Bannockburn, bequeathed Bathgate Castle along with the Barony of Bathgate to Walter the sixth High Steward of Scotland upon his marriage to Bruce's daughter Princess Marjorie in 1315.

Walter had served with distinction as one of Bruce's most able Deputies at Bannockburn. From there he was dispatched to bring Princess Marjorie back from incarceration at a Gilbertine convent in Watton Yorkshire, where she had been held captive since Bruce lost the Battle of Methven in 1306. A true love story unfolded and Bruce was by all accounts delighted to give his daughter's hand in marriage to Walter. Sadly Walter and Marjorie were only afforded just over two years together before her tragic death aged only 20 as a result of a fall from her horse near Paisley Abbey. In 1371 aged 55, their son became King Robert the second of Scotland, after Mariorie's half brother David the second died. On taking the throne, he adopted the name Stuart which is derived from his father's titles.

The future King Robert spent many of

his formative years living with his father Walter in Bathgate Castle before Walter's sad early death in 1327. Our castle seems to have been effectively abandoned soon after Walter's death but if you look from above, the foundations are still clearly visible 700 years later.

The Royal House of Stuart has its foundations firmly here in our treasured town. During the second Jacobite Rebellion of 1745 / 1746 it is documented the young Pretender himself, Charles Edward Stuart, spent three days lodging in Bathgate with the Norvell family at their Boghall Mansion. I'm sure the Bonnie Prince was curious to see the lands his illustrious forebearers inhabited.

So when you see Princess Marjorie , Walter the Sixth Lord High Steward and King Robert himself on Procession Day give an extra loud cheer for our young ambassadors filling these roles and remember Bathgate's integral part in the formation of the Royal House of Stuart.

## SHARING OUR HISTORY WITH THE NEXT GENERATION



At 11am on the steps of the Old Academy, Bathgate bairns come together to reenact a significant event in our history. With the exception of Robert The Bruce, children of primary and secondary school age who attend a Bathgate school or live in Bathgate are invited to take part in the pageant.

King Robert the Bruce's eldest child, Marjorie was married to Walter Lord High Steward and part of the dowry included the Barony of Bathgate and the Key to Bathgate Castle. The castle was in the grounds of today's Bathgate Golf club, but unfortunately there are no remains.
