Bathgate Procession began as a Founder's Day Parade on 17th April 1844, in remembrance of John Newland's contribution to the building of Bathgate Academy.

180 Years of Bathgate Procession





With the day designated as a holiday for the town, school pupils marched from The Old Academy on that day along Marjoribanks Street to The High Church (now Bathgate Parish Church). In 1849 after the service in the Parish Church, the pupils marched through the town and thus began the tradition of a parade.

Many changes occured over the years including the addition of the historical pageant in which local school children had starring roles such as archers and guards. In 1924, the pageant introduced the roles of Princess Marjorie and Walter, Lord High Steward of Scotland, who are the main characters in the historical pageant to this day.

BATHGATE PROCESSION ORATION

A HOLE IN ONE FOR BATHGATE

I am delighted to announce Mr Stephen Gallacher as Bathgate Procession and Community Festival's Orator for 2024.

Born to Jim, a British Leyland worker and Wilma, a Nurse at Bangour where Stephen was born into a family whose sporting blood lines were strong.

His love of golf started from a very young age with his father putting his name down to be a member of Bathgate Golf Club at just a day old! At three years old, with a plastic club set, Stephen managed to hit a marble through his front window. He continues to follow his passion for his sport to this day albeit on a course rather than in his living room.

The family moved from Bathgate to Livingston and onto Aberdeen for Stephens dad's work during his primary school years, where his main hobby was football rather than golf. However, they moved back to their hometown where Stephen attended Bathgate Academy. He soon gave up football and attended Bathgate Golf Club after school and sometimes even when he should have been at school. He spent many a night using his first set of clubs at Polkemmet Driving Range. The clubs were bought by his great uncle Johnny Gallacher, who was a massive influence on his development in golf.

"All I wanted to do was to be a professional golfer and Bathgate Golf Club was the platform for me to do it. Seeing Eric Brown and my uncle Bernard's portraits hanging proudly in the lounge at the club donning their Ryder Cup attire was what gave me my goal of emulating them playing in a Ryder Cup one day".

Stephen's long list of successes would take many pages to cover but here are some of the highlights. He won the Scottish Amateur Match Play, the Scottish Amateur Championship and the Lytham Trophy in a glittering amateur career which culminated in forming part of the victorious Great Britain and Ireland Walker Cup team at Royal Porthcawl in 1995.

Stephen claimed a European Tour card in his first attempt in 1995 and has since won four European Tour titles, including two at the Omega Dubai Desert Classic. He secured his first win for five years when he triumphed at the Hero Indian Open in March 2019. In 2014 Stephen fulfilled a lifelong dream

by playing in The Ryder Cup in his home country of Scotland, forming part of Paul McGinley's winning European side at Gleneagles Resort.

A renowned supporter and mentor to aspiring young Scottish golfers, he plays a hands-on role in the Stephen Gallacher Foundation which was launched in 2012. Its aim is to give all children the opportunity to learn and enjoy the game of golf in a fun environment.

Bathgate will always hold a special place in Stephen's heart as it's where he spent hours and hours honing his golf skills but most importantly where he met his wife Helen and had his children Jack and Ellie. Stephen moved to Linlithgow where his kids went to Linlithgow Primary and Academy but after 16 years, he moved back to

Bathgate to be closer to his mum, sister Jennifer, brother-in-law Paul and their children Oliver and Lily.

To Stephen the Procession is and always will be about family. He has fond memories of his family congregating at his Great Auntie Bella's house in Gideon Street to watch the Procession, come hail or shine and where a big family buffet would be tucked into afterwards.

Stephen said agreeing to be the 2024 Orator was an easy decision to make given that his wife Helen's mum Betty and her husband Robert helped build the Bathgate Community Centre float for years and for his love of his hometown.

Stephen will deliver his oration covering his love of sport and his hometown of Bathgate on Friday 31st May, 8pm at Bathgate Parish Church.

On behalf of Bathgate we would like to offer massive congratulations!





THE HALBERDIER

A GUARD WHO CARRIES A HALBERD AS A SYMBOL OF HIS DUTY

Not many have held the coveted title of "Halberdier" but those who have, have carried out their duty with honour and pride.

No real record of Halberdiers has been maintained over the years and much information has been dependent on memory. However, thanks to Rachael Hossack and the Bennie Museum we have managed to find some information on the role. We would love to know more about this role so if you are a budding historian and have any further information/photos/facts/dates etc we would love to hear from you.

The "Leader of the Procession" or "The Leader" was someone well known in Bathgate who had taken a keen interest in the Procession and carried a Mace on the Procession route. Historic leaders were Alex Flemming (1912) and A Strathern (1927). Unfortunately the Mace was extremely heavy so a Halberd was designed and manufactured giving this new title to the person who carried it - "The Halberdier".

Halberdier Daniel Banks led the procession from approximately 1938 until 1954 when Jock Binning took over until 1967. Jock's son Andra took over from his father until 1984. In 1984 Jock Pollock took on the role until 1990. In 1991 Wullie Steven (a well kent face in Bathgate) led the Procession until the global pandemic caused the cancellation of the Procession. In 2022 Billy Weir (a previous Bathgate Procession Committee member) proudly agreed to be the Halberdier and according to Billy he has a good few years left in him yet leading the Procession!






